#### Budget Review:

Brent Hogan review the budget. The largest portion of the money goes to para-professional salaries. The money we had budgeted for the student advocate was reimbursed by funds from the Roy Cone project so we have that money to carry over. Moby Max has not yet been paid. There is \$6200 in instructional equipment and the hope is to use this money for replacing and obtaining Chromebooks. The carryover from last year is \$1931.

#### Title One Plan:

Brent Hogan discussed the Title One plan and budget. The largest portion of funds are used for teacher's salaries and benefits. We used about \$1800 of the \$5000 parent involvement for our first literacy night. Funds are being used to purchase a sub for each teacher in a grade level team so they can have an uninterrupted team day.

#### Leader in Me:

Brent Hogan informed the council that the faculty and staff at Roy Elementary are hoping to implement The Leader in Me program next year. The program is designed to give all students leadership responsibilities so students will respect the school, peers, teachers and staff. It helps students make life goals. Teachers and staff would be required to attend three days of seven habits training and would receive a small stipend to attend. Two more days would be scheduled during the school year to do further training. Brent explained that he is applying for a grant to help with some of the cost for the first year start-up and that some Title One and Trustlands funds would need to be used to cover the rest of the cost. Council members expressed that they felt the program was a good way to spend the funds.

**Bylaws Update:**

It was proposed by Janene Salt that we change the bylaws to include a required time for minutes of the community council meetings to be posted. It was proposed that they be posted no later than one week after the meeting. Nelida gil made a motion to accept the change and Jerry Wilkins seconded.
