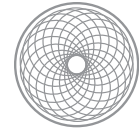
Community Council Minutes

Meeting summary from Thursday, October 30, 2014 at 6:00 pm held in the school library.

Members who were present:

Ms. Shelly Roberts (Principal), Janene Salt, MaryLee Schoenfeld (Secretary), Amy Steele, Valerie Schenk, Jon England, and Judy Frigaard (visitor)

- Ms. Roberts conducted the meeting.
- It is necessary for us to elect a new president. Janene Salt nominated Michelle Scott as the new Community Council President. There was a second on on the motion by Valerie Schenk. Voting was unanimous in favor of Michelle Scott as the new president.
- A review of the trustland plan turned in last spring for this current school year was necessary. A section needed to be added to address some carryover. We plan to use some monies for supporting some new technology services provided by the district.. Some money was held out due to so many changes to the faculty at the end of the school year. Nearly every team in the school had some sort of change and until those changes were set in place, plans couldn't be made for some of the funding plans made at the previous community council meeting. Those funds will be spent this year if they are approved.
- A motion was made to re-open the plan to include an increase for reading support and attendance by Jon England. Second motion was made by Valerie Schenk. Voting was unanimous in favor of opening the plan.
- Ms. Roberts gave an update on the Focus School Situation. Teachers are currently undergoing more training for increasing student involvement in lessons. Still not for sure a focus school, but will continue teacher training until more information on this becomes available.
