2014-15 Goals Review: School goal was to have students K-3 at benchmark in dibels by the end of the year. K=82%, 1=62%, 2=80% and 3=76%. Cross age reading is being done to try to help increase the skills of those not on benchmark. Teachers are doing a lot with small and whole group instruction. The district has to report all 3rd grade scores to the state. The goal for the district is 82.5%.

2015-2016 Goals

- 82% K-3 will read at benchmark by end of year
- Increase student math proficiency by 10% on 2016 Sage
- Decrease absences by 10% for our most chronically absent students-In a comparison done from the first 4 weeks of school this year to the 2013-14 school year-students with 2 or more absences has reduced more than half, our AmeriCorps (name?)Person is making big differences by communicating very well with parents. Students that were chronically absent last year, are tardy some days, but they are here, they are happy and ready to learn.

- Schools/Districts are graded in the PACE reporting system and given a letter grade. Our school received a C in 2013-14 and a C in 2014. But overall we increased from 242 points in 2013-14 to 274 points in 2014-15-32 points is big growth. Our proficiency level in ELA and Math is low but we had a lot of growth in both areas. Science- not too much growth-we need to focus on this academic area.
